

At Torburnlea, we understand that your vacation is meant to be a time for relaxation and rejuvenation. That's why we have a dedicated team of staff members to ensure that your stay is comfortable and hassle-free.

Florence is our housekeeper who comes in twice a day to make sure that your dishes are clean, the house is kept neat and tidy, and the beds are made. She also locks up after you depart to ensure the safety of your belongings. In the winter, Florence will lay the fires daily and bring in firewood to keep you warm and cozy. While Florence is paid by the group, we recommend a gratuity of R100 per occupied bedroom to show your appreciation for her hard work.

Saul is our groundskeeper, who is responsible for maintaining the area around the dam and houses. He also chops firewood, ensuring that you always have enough to keep the fire burning. Saul takes pride in his work and loves to see guests enjoying their stay. We encourage you to consider giving him a tip as well, as a small gesture of gratitude for his efforts.



Fishing

For all the fishing enthusiasts out there, Torburnlea offers a great opportunity to enjoy fly fishing in a serene and picturesque environment.

The main dam, Dam 7, is a fantastic spot for fly fishing, and we have boats available both at the house and cottage for your convenience. The dam is perfect for float tubes and is regularly stocked, ensuring that you have plenty of opportunities to catch.

We also maintain and stock Dam 9, providing you with additional fishing opportunities during your stay.

To ensure that our fishing resources are sustained for years to come, we encourage our guests to practice catch and release fishing. However, if you choose to keep your catch, the limit is 4 fish per week at the house and 2 fish per week at the cottage.

We take great pride in maintaining our fishing areas and ask that you respect our fishing rules to ensure that our waters remain pristine and healthy for future generations to enjoy.













Activities

At Torburnlea, there is a variety of outdoor activities for our guests to enjoy.

If you are an adventure seeker, you'll be pleased to know that there are many farm roads that wind their way through the Sappi Forest, providing the perfect opportunity for mountain biking enthusiasts to explore the area's natural beauty.

For those who prefer a leisurely pace, there are scenic walks up to the fire observation post and cell tower, where you can marvel at the outstanding views of the dams and the surrounding areas.

If you're a nature lover, you'll be delighted to know that Torburnlea is home to a diverse range of bird life, including Fish eagles, which you can spot while enjoying your stay.

The area is also a natural habitat for small buck, black-backed jackal, porcupines, snakes, and even leopard spoor has been spotted.

A family of otters are resident in the large dam. If you are lucky you can often see them around the reeds in the early evening.

We encourage our guests to enjoy the natural surroundings while being mindful of the wildlife in their natural habitat.



At the Church, turn left on the road to Badplaas.

Travel about 14.7 km on the road turn left at the first tar road Slaaihoek /Nkomati Mine

Then approx. 2km further turn left onto the first dirt road to Waterfall Boven

1.8km along the dirt road, you will find Torburnlea on the left
